Management of the school will be liable to pay the salary to the
Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff in parity with the staff of Govt.
Schools. Failing which this No Objection certificate can be
withdrawn immediately.
4. That in case at any time if any kind of information
is demanded by your District Education Officer or by any Senior

Officer of Education Department, and the necessary information will be supplied to him and all kinds of cooperation will be given to him.
